

WHAT DOES IT COST TO ATTEND ODYSSEY LEADERSHIP ACADEMY?

Odyssey Leadership Academy is committed to providing an opportunity to learn for each and every student! It is for this reason that Odyssey Leadership Academy operates in public spaces, rather than constructing buildings. We believe that each and every dollar given to us should go to supporting human beings, not buildings.

Tuition at Odyssey Leadership Academy for the 2018/19 school year will run:

- \$ \$8,000 for 2018/19 school year for both OLA and OYLA
- \$500 multi-child discount for families with more than one child attending Odyssey Leadership Academy
- Three separate Excursion Costs at \$850 each trip

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION?

Every family must:

- Complete the background questionnaire that includes an introductory letter about themselves, their goals, and what they are seeking from their experience here
- Engage in a face-to-face discussion with the Deans of that school

WHERE DO YOU MEET?

Odyssey Leadership Academy has our hub in the Kingman Building in Bricktown and also makes use of public spaces (such as libraries, nonprofit centers, office spaces, etc.) for the following reasons:

- To keep our overhead costs down so that we can provide the highest quality educational experience to each and every student
- To make use of whole communities rather than enclosed buildings by utilizing the surrounding areas connected to the public spaces, including parks, museums, coffee shops, office complexes, neighborhood community centers (like a local YMCA), non-profits, design studios, local theaters, etc.
- To ensure that every dollar given to us goes directly to human beings and not to building campaigns

HOW MANY STUDENTS CAN ATTEND?

Odyssey Leadership Academy caps enrollment at 150 students to enable deep relationships to develop between Mentors and students and students-to-students, believing that smaller class sizes lead to deeper understanding, development, and support.

Once a given school reaches 150 students, it is our desire to relationally open another school in the next area of need and desire. Our long-term goal is to replicate the model whenever and wherever communities express a need.

WHAT ABOUT THE ACT AND COLLEGE?

Our average ACT score is 26. Graduates from OLA matriculate into colleges and universities around the country, many earning significant scholarship opportunities to their top schools of choice.

Current OLA graduates are also going beyond academics and serving and studying around the country and around the world: in Jordan (Youth With a Mission), Switzerland (L'Abri), and Serve Seattle (Seattle).
